KEY INSIGHTS ON TEENAGE PREGNANCY

- 1. There are **many cases** of teenage pregnancy among residents of informal settlements.
 - Majority of TCB clients are young people 15-24 years (43.98% of the total clientele). Out of these, 18.26% are teen mothers.
 - To date TCB has helped **over 40 teenage mums** in Mukuru Kayaba and Mukuru Kwa Ruben.
- 2. Majority of the teen mothers are married, 84.4% while the rest are single but with child.
- 3. Majority of the teen mothers have **only basic education** and are thus very clueless on maternal and newborn health.
 - 1.8% of the teen mothers have no formal education
 - 34.4% of the teen mothers have primary education only
 - **58.95%** of the teen mothers have secondary education only
- 4. High poverty levels, lack of education and inaccessibility to maternal health services makes teen mothers highly vulnerable and in need of help.
 - Most married teens are housewives with no income earning jobs.
 - For married teens, the basic household income level ranges between **0-5,000 Kshs**.
